







**Past Simple:** to form affirmative sentences in the past it's necessary to know the difference between them:



I **appreciated** that food. - **base form:** a preciate She **decided** to study more. - **base form:** decide

Irregular verbs - are verbs totally different from the base form.

Exemples:

He **gave** me flowers. - **base form:** give

We had a wonderful weekend. - base form: have
