Para se mexer:

Past Simple: to form affirmative sentences in the past it's necessary to know the difference between them:

- ▶ **Regular verbs** - are verbs ended with **D/ED/IED**.

Exemplos:

I **appreciated** that food. - **base form:** appreciate

She **decided** to study more. - **base form:** decide

- ▶ **Irregular verbs** - are verbs **totally different** from the base form.

Exemplos:

He **gave** me flowers. - **base form:** give

We **had** a wonderful weekend. - **base form:** have
