## Para se mexer:

**Adverbs of time:** tell us when an action **happened** (aconteceu), but also for **how long** (por quanto tempo) and **how often** (com que frequência).

**Present:** everyday; right now; every Sunday; once a week; always; never

(**Presente:** todos os dias; agora mesmo; todo domingo; uma vez por semana; sempre; nunca)

I call her **every day**.

She organizes the bedroom **once a week**.

**Past:** yesterday; the day before yesterday; last Saturday; last week; a month ago

(**Passado:** ontem; antes de ontem; último sábado; semana passada; um mês atrás)

Vivian went shopping **last Saturday**

Pauline and Fred got married **a month ago**.

**Future:** tomorrow; the day after tomorrow; next Monday; in a few days; in two weeks; soon

(**Futuro:** amanhã; depois de amanhã; próxima Segunda; em poucos dias; em duas semanas; logo)

She is going to the doctor **in two weeks**.

You'll have a baby **in a few days**.


