Para se mexer:

Adverbs of time: tell us when an action happened (aconteceu), but also for how long (por quanto tempo) and how often (com que frequência).

Present: everyday; right now; every Sunday; once a week; always; never

(**Presente**: todos os dias; agora mesmo; todo domingo; uma vez por semana; sempre; nunca)

I call her every day.

She organizes the bedroom once a week.

Past: yesterday; the day before yesterday; last Saturday; last week; a month ago

(**Passado**: ontem; antes de ontem; último sábado; semana passada; um mês atrás)

Vivian went shopping last Saturday

Pauline and Fred got married a month ago.

Future: tomorrow; the day after tomorrow; next Monday; in a few days; in two weeks; soon

(**Futuro**: amanhã; depois de amanhã; próxima Segunda; em poucos dias; em duas semanas; logo)

She is going to the doctor in two weeks.
