Para se mexer:

How much...? (quantity) is used with uncountable nouns (incontáveis: quanto/quanta).

How much time do we have to finish the test?

How much money did you spend?

How much...? (price) is used with countable nouns (contáveis) when we want to know the price of something.

How much is that painting?

How much are those tennis shoes?

How many...? (quantity) is used when we want to know the quantity of something with countable nouns (contáveis).

How many days are in January?

How many people work in your company?

Some/Any are used to state the quantify.

I have **some** money

He doesn't have **any** money.

Do you have **any** money?

In general

We use **some** in **affirmative sentences**.

We use **any** in **negative** and **interrogative sentences**

Exceptions

We use **some** in the **interrogative form** when **offering or requesting something**:

Would you like **some** coffee? (**offer**)

Can I have **some** water? (**request**)

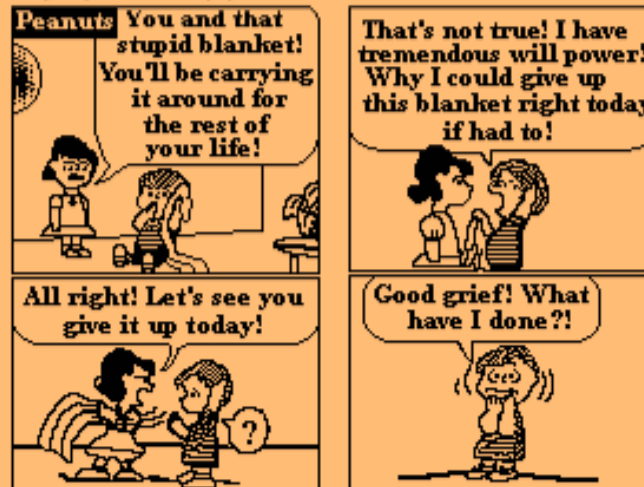
