Para se mexer:

Present Continuous is used for actions **happening now** (acontecendo agora) or for an action that is unfinished:

We form by: **SUBJECT + VERB TO BE + VERB (ING) + COMPLEMENT**

They **are singing** in the church.

The baby **is sleeping** in the crib.

The boys **are arguing** because of the game.

Negative form: to write these sentences in the negative form we add **NOT**.

Interrogative form: in the interrogative form we invert subject and the verb to be.
