

Neste Guia, você vai estudar **“Present Continuous/Progressive”**.

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Para se mexer:

The Present Continuous/Progressive - is a verb tense which is used to show an action that is happening now or at the moment of speaking.

Subject + verb to be + ING in the main verb + complement

For example:

You are **learning** English now

They are **celebrating** her birthday.

Yury is **playing** handball right now.

Jenny is **talking** with her father.



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Don't forget

Verbs ending with **E**- we take it and replace by **ING- close**: He is **closing** the door.

Verbs that the three last letters are **CVC** consonant-vowel-consonant- **we repeat** the last letter and add **ING- cut**: The boys are **cutting** the papers.

Negative form - In the negative form we add **NOT** after the verb to be.

For example:

They are **not** celebrating her birthday.

Jenny is **not** talking to her father.



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Interrogative form - In the interrogative **form the verb to be** begins the sentences.

For example:

Are they celebrating her birthday?

Is Jenny talking to her father?

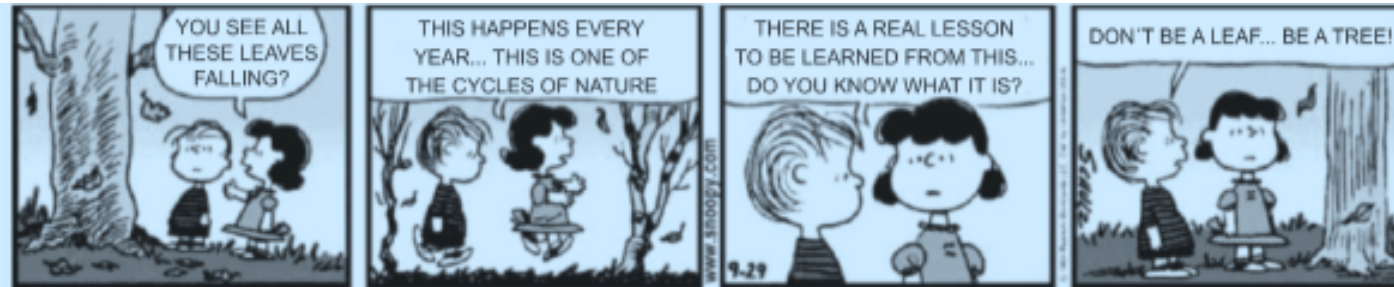
No diálogo entre mãe e filho, o uso do verbo *fake* pelo garoto indica que ele
