before subjects (antes dos sujeitos)

The dog **which** is sick is ours.



whose (de quem, cujo, cuja)

that (aquele, aquilo)

Whose car is this?

The girl whose hair is blond is my sister.

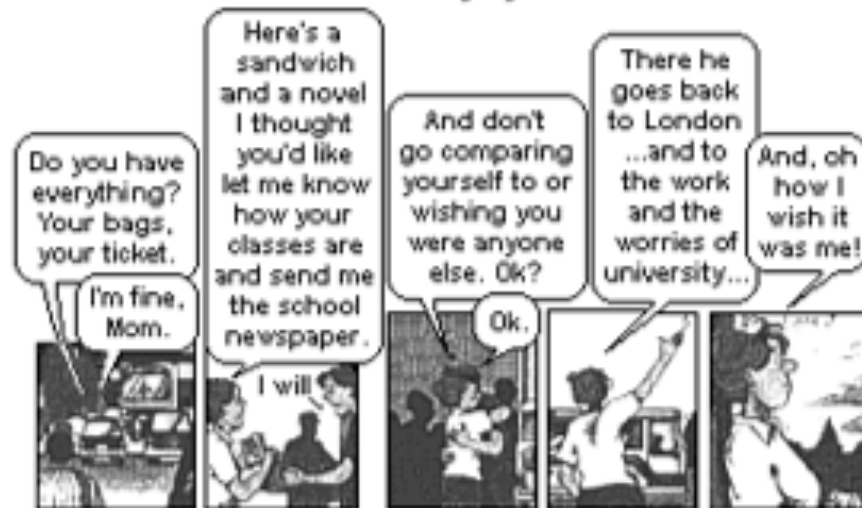
