Para se mexer:

If clauses I: refer to an action in the future that **will only happen** if a **certain condition** occurs at that time.

It is formed by: **If + Simple present + will + verb**

If I find her address, **I will send** her an invitation.

The main clause can also be **at the beginning** of the sentence.

I will send her an invitation, **if I find** her address.



Negative form: we just add in the

- **Present simple** the auxiliary - don't/doesn't.
- **Future** - won't.

If John **has** the money, he **will buy** a new car.

If John **doesn't have** the money, he **won't buy** the car.

If they **practice** a lot, they will win the game.

If they **don't practice** a lot, they **won't win** the game.
