Para se mexer:

Going to: when you are talking about actions that you will do soon (**tomorrow or next week**).

She is **going to** have a baby **next week**.

They **are not going to** play soccer **after class**.

My parents **are going to** the grocery **after lunch**.

Is Bruce **going to** buy a new car **this week**?



Will: when you are talking about actions that are far into the future (months or maybe years from now).

They **will** travel to Europe **in 2021**.

He **will** graduate **in the end of the year**.

I **won't** go to the school **this year**.

Will she take her driver's license **in 2022?**

You can use this tense in a **future action** that you have decided **in the moment of speaking**.

"I'm thirsty! I think I **will** buy a drink."

"This is so expensive! But I **will** be able to afford this someday."

"Okay, I **will** go to your party!"
