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## Para se mexer:

**Present perfect:** we form this verb tense with.

**SUBJECT + HAVE/HAS + PARTICIPLE + COMPLEMENT**

My teacher **has taught** many important things. (irregular verb)

She **has ridden** a horse since she was 10. (irregular verb)

They **have planned** many things. (regular verb)

We have **woken up** earlier for 3 months. (regular verb)



**Negative form:** we add not after the auxiliary have/has.

She **hasn't** ridden a horse since she was 10.

They **haven't** planned many things.



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**Interrogative form:** we invert the auxiliary and the subject.

**Has she** ridden a horse since she was 10?

**Have they** planned many things?
