Para se mexer:

Past continuous - we form by **SUBJECT + WAS/WERE + VERB (ING) + COMPLEMENT.**

- We use to talk about **the past**.
The children **were doing** their homework.
- We use at the **beginning of a story**.
The other day, I **was waiting** for a bus when...
- We use that happened **before and after** a specific time.
It was eight o' clock, I **was writing** a letter.



Negative form - to write these sentences in the negative form we add **NOT**.

The children **were doing** homework.

The children **were not** (weren't) doing homework.

I **was waiting** for the bus when....

I **was not** (wasn't) waiting for a bus when..

Interrogative form - WAS/WERE: come in the beginning of the sentence.

- **Were the children** doing homework?
- **Was I** waiting for the bus when...?
